
Paraphrased Treaty Article

Article II: The United States agrees that the land between the 37th degree of north latitude and old Fort Defiance and west of Greenwich, including Canon-de-Chilly, will be set apart for the Navajo reservation. The United States agrees that no one except the people of the Navajo Nation and some officers, soldiers, agents, and employees of the United States government will be allowed to enter the Navajo lands
