Buffalo populations in the mid-nineteenth century were estimated at thirty to sixty million. By the 1890s, that number had shrunk to one thousand. Today, organizations like the Intertribal Buffalo Council have been powerful forces in rebuilding bison populations with a membership of fifty-six Native Nations and a collective herd of more than fifteen thousand bison.
